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
Welcome to Cartoon Network Magazine!

Red, blue, you name it. Hair color is sometimes used to separate aliens and monsters from normal people. But, depending on the artist, odd hair colors can be used just because they look good.



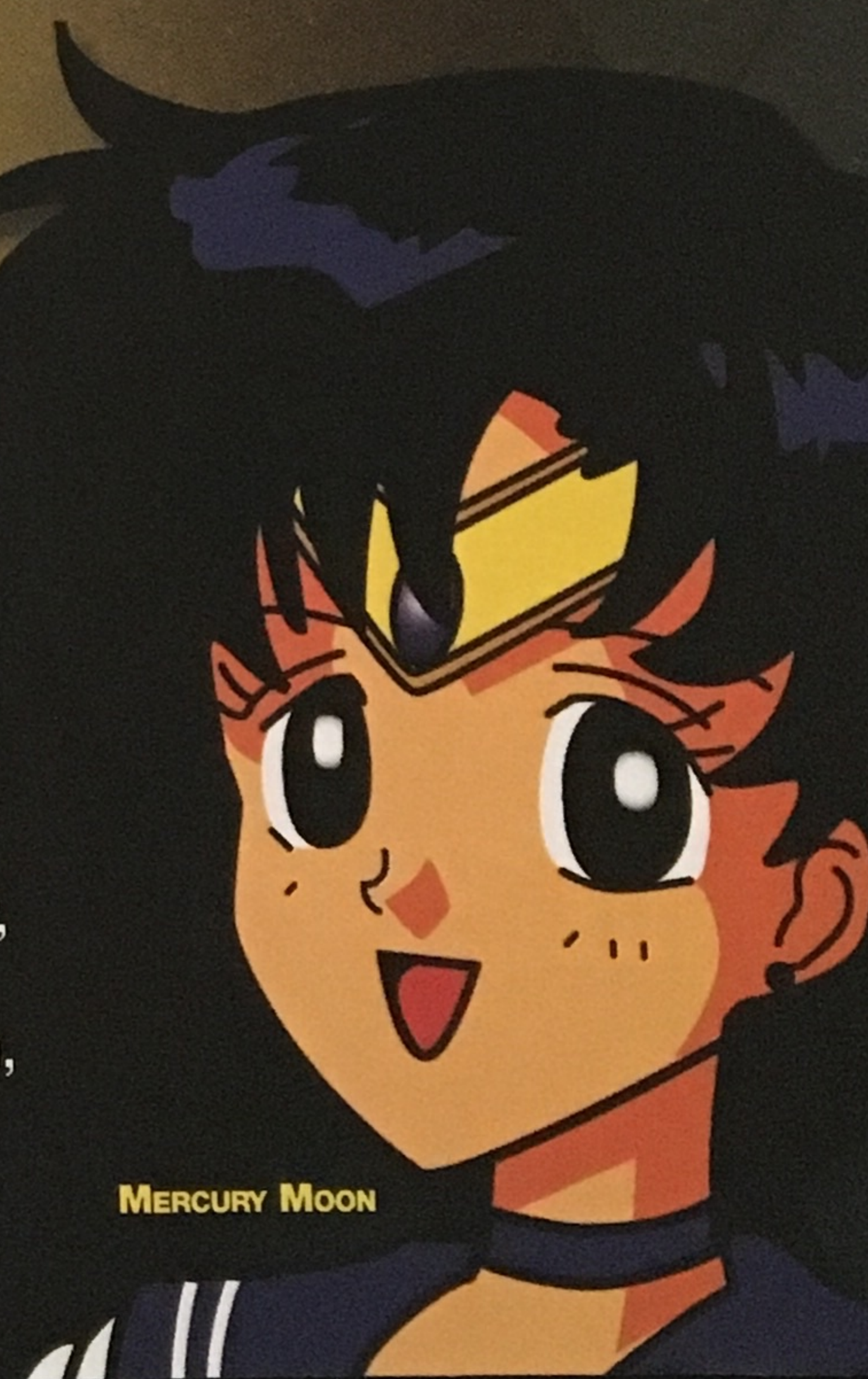

(show-nen, sho-jo, koh-doh-moh) adjectives. Specific visual and storytelling anime styles.

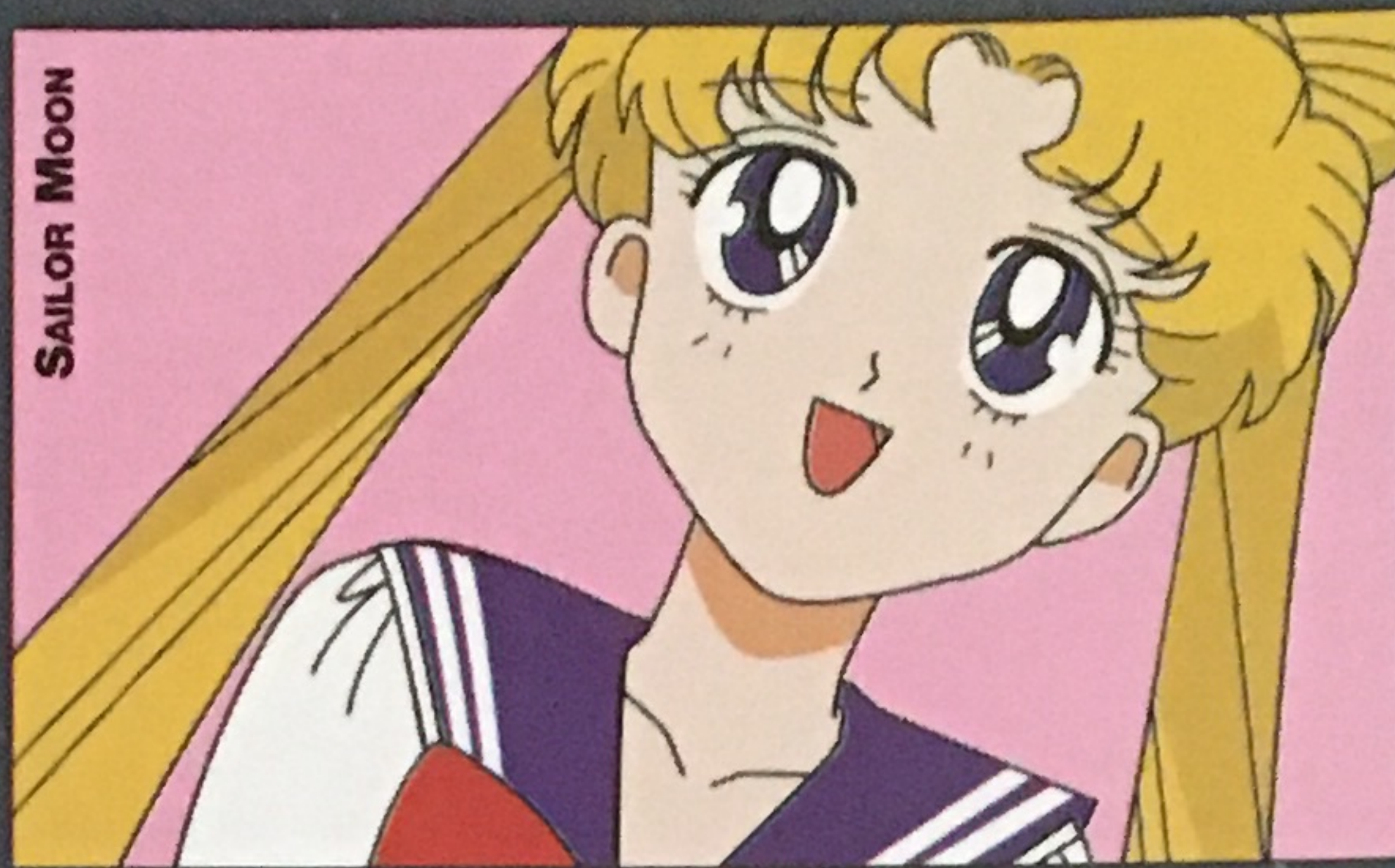
Shounen

Shounen is typically big action-adventure stories aimed at boys, though not restricted to boys alone (*Dragon Ball*, *Dragon Ball Z*, *Rurouni Kenshin*, *Gundam Wing* and *Giant Robo*).



Kodomo

Kodomo is usually lighthearted fantasies for small children (*Doraemon*, *Hello Kitty* and *Bad Badtz-Maru*).



Shoujo

Shoujo is aimed more toward girls. It usually features romantic dramas with beautiful artwork (*Sailor Moon*, *Revolutionary Girl Utena* and *Magic Knight Rayearth*).

Manga (man-guh), noun. Japanese comic books, which are often the basis of anime. Unlike American comics, manga generally have long stories — that is, huge stories, sometimes thousands of pages over several volumes.

Everybody in Japan reads manga. It's read as much as magazines or books. Moms and dads, businesspeople and construction workers — there is a manga for everyone!

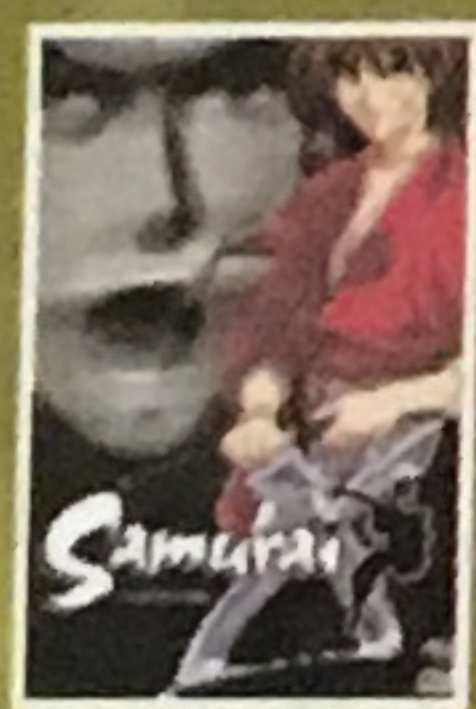

Nadia: The Secret of Blue Water

Inspired by Jules Verne's *20,000 Leagues Under the Sea*, this anime follows a young inventor and a mysterious girl (and her pet lion) on an adventure across the high seas. They search for Nadia's homeland and the secret of the Blue Water jewel Nadia wears.



The Slayers

Follows the adventures of Lina, a sorceress with a penchant for hurling fireballs, and her companion Gourry as they look for adventure and riches. Of course they manage to save the world along the way and escape from Zelgadis, a magical swordsman made of stone.



Iria: Zeiram the Animation

A young bounty hunter must trek across the universe to stop the world-destroying monster Zeiram, and expose the secret, evil organization that is after him.

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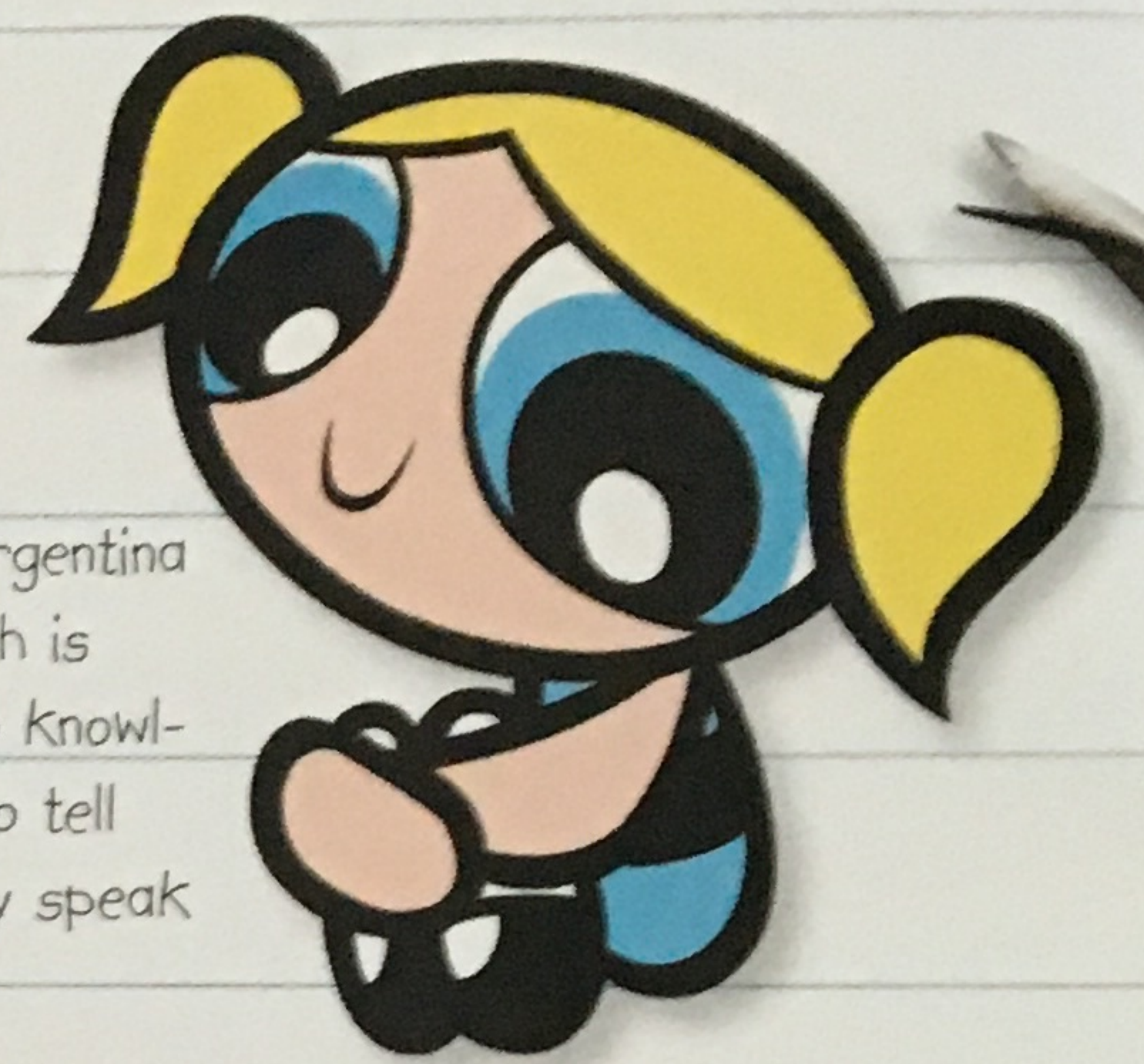

That's right! Even though it's not the world's highest peak, it's on the bulge of the equator, so it's further away from the center of the earth.

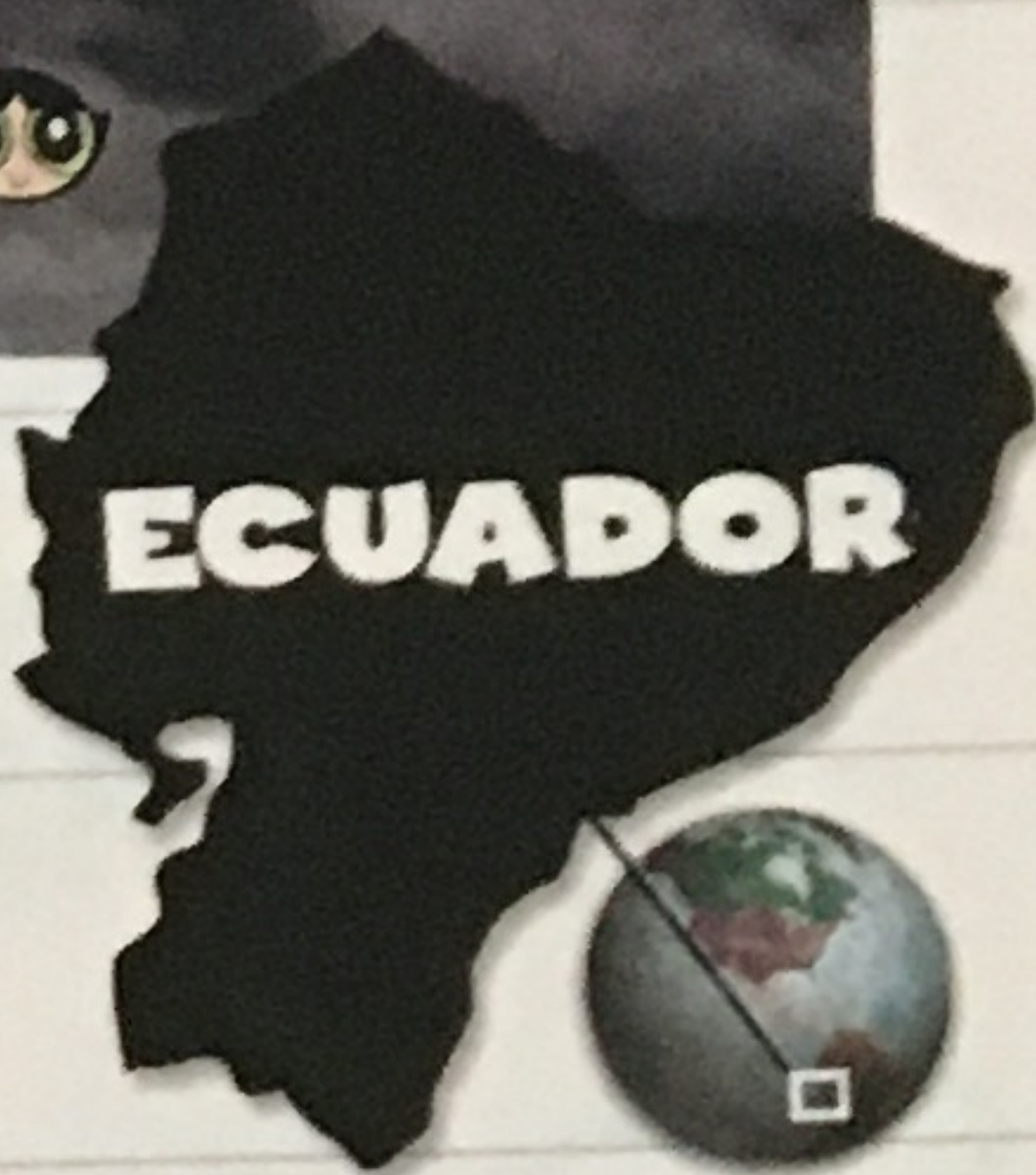
